



# What to Pack

# Caribbean Cruise

A Caribbean cruise is a wonderful way to relax and enjoy some island magic.

On most ships the dress will be casual both day and evening, but it's great to have options to dress up if you choose.

## 1. Choose your luggage

### • Primary Bag

*This bag will be collected at the dock for delivery to your stateroom later in the day.*

### • Day bag

*Include all valuables and everything you will need on your day of arrival on the ship.*

### • Flight Bag

*Small bag - This bag should fit inside your day bag. Put it in your seat pocket before takeoff.*

- [opt] travel belt  
*or similar, worn during flight.*

**LOCK ALL BAGS, including those stored in the overhead compartment.**

## 2. Clothing

- Climate - warm to HOT
- **To Pack Light**
  - Choose a light neutral for 3 pieces – bottom, top and topper.
  - Pack lightweight, odor resistant clothing, i.e. merino wool
  - Add brights and prints to coordinate.
  - Each piece should go with at least 2 others.
  - Check whether laundry services are available on your ship.

## WEAR IN TRANSIT

- Shoes, heaviest
- Pants, travel comfortable
- Top, short sleeve
- Sweater, lightweight
- Scarf or pashmina

## IN YOUR FLIGHT BAG

- Tablet and/or phone
- eReader
- Noise-canceling headphones
- Notebook and pen
- Neck pillow, inflatable
- Medications needed during flight
- Pain relievers and low-dose aspirin
- Moisturizer
- Lip balm
- Hand sanitizer
- Face mask
- Cleansing wipes
- Toothbrush, paste, floss
- Deodorant
- Eye drops
- Hairbrush
- Water bottle – fill in terminal
- Emergen-C and/or electrolyte powder [optional]

## IN YOUR DAYBAG

- Cruise tickets
- Itinerary
- Insurance and health information
- Camera, lenses
- Binoculars [optional]
- Laptop and charger [optional]
- Chargers for all electronics
- Jewelry – costume is best, don't bring anything you would regret losing!
- Medications, prescription, and OTC
- Motion sickness medications
- Sunglasses
- Sunscreen, reef safe
- Swimsuit & cover-up
- Sandals, casual
- 1 complete outfit, (inc. undergarments) suitable for first night's supper on board.

## IN YOUR WALLET

- Passport
- Visa [if needed]
- Bank Cards & ID  
[alert banks to travel plans]

## IN YOUR PRIMARY BAG

- Copy of passport  
[email copies to yourself]
- Bottoms, shorts, or capris (2)
- Tops, casual (2)
- Tops, dressy (2)
- T-shirts (1-2)
- Dress or skirt (1-2)
- Pajamas
- Workout clothes
- Swimsuit
- Swim cover-up
- Socks (2)
- Undergarments
- Sandals or flats, dressy
- Flip flops [optional]
- Sun hat
- Rain jacket
- Power strip with USB ports
- Camera – memory cards
- Camera battery – spare and charger
- Lens cleaning wipes
- Folding tote bag  
[for beach or shopping]
- Woolite packets
- Feminine products

*Tip: Take a picture of your bag and its contents. Helpful in finding lost luggage*

## OPTIONAL EXTRAS

- Formal wear (dependent on cruise line)
- Sundress
- Snorkeling gear (usually provided on excursions but we like our own)
- Water shoes
- Waterproof camera
- Lanyard for cruise card
- Magnetic hooks for cruise cabin
- AirTag or Tile if checking luggage
